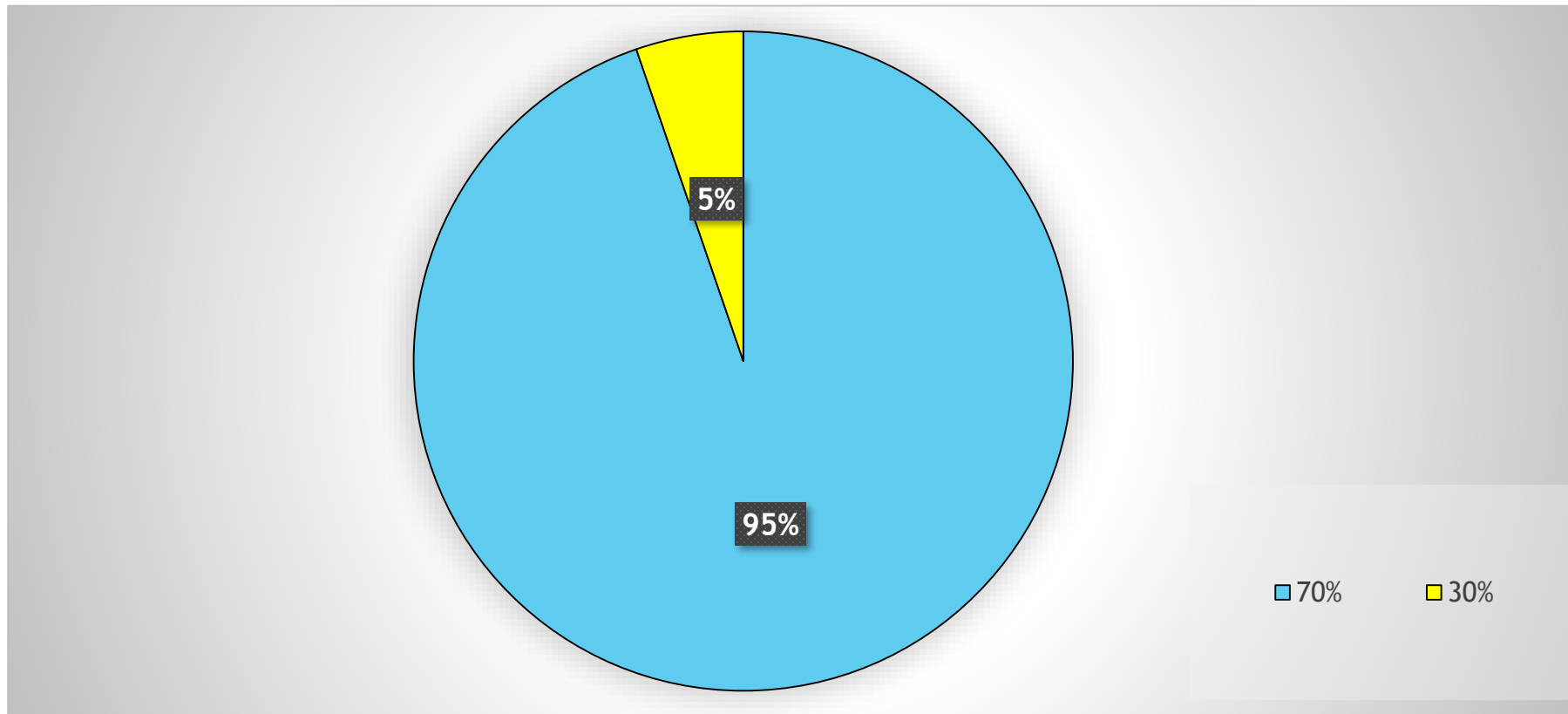

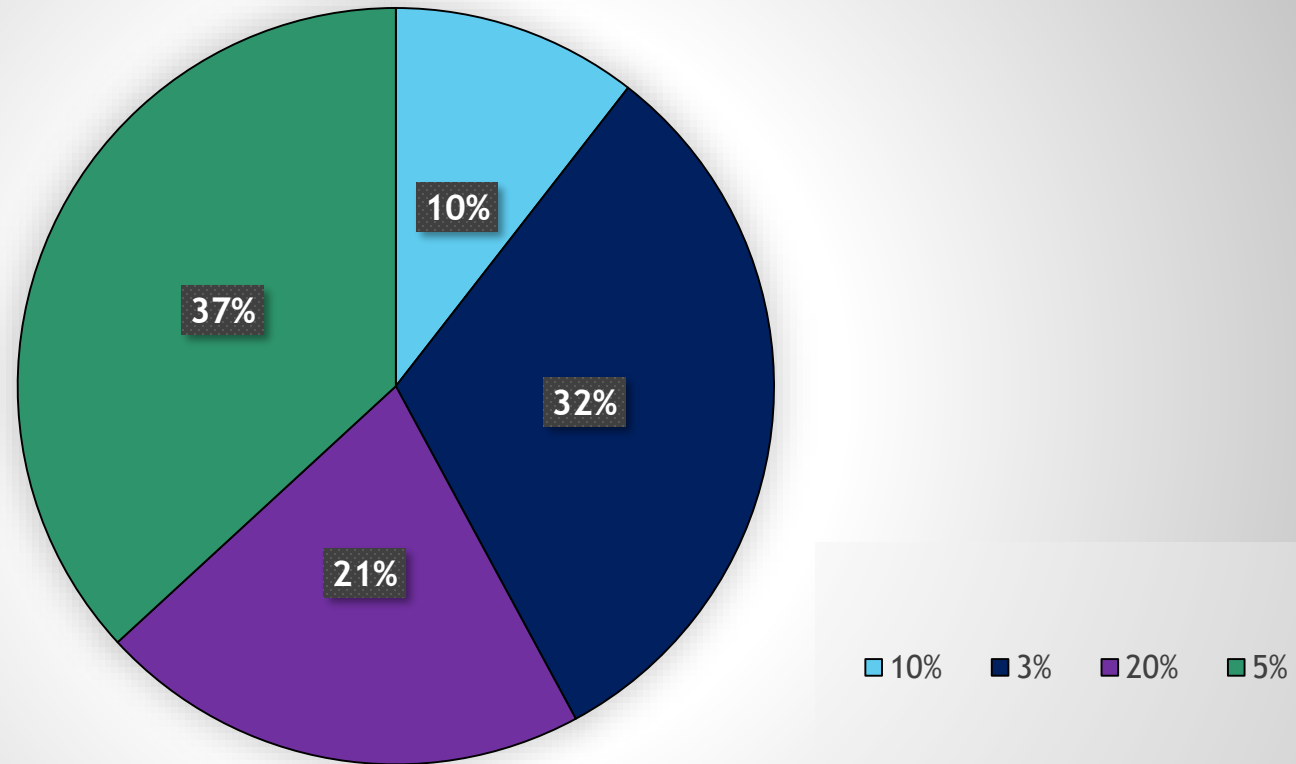
# Questionnaire for pupils

- ▶ 19 students participated in the poll.

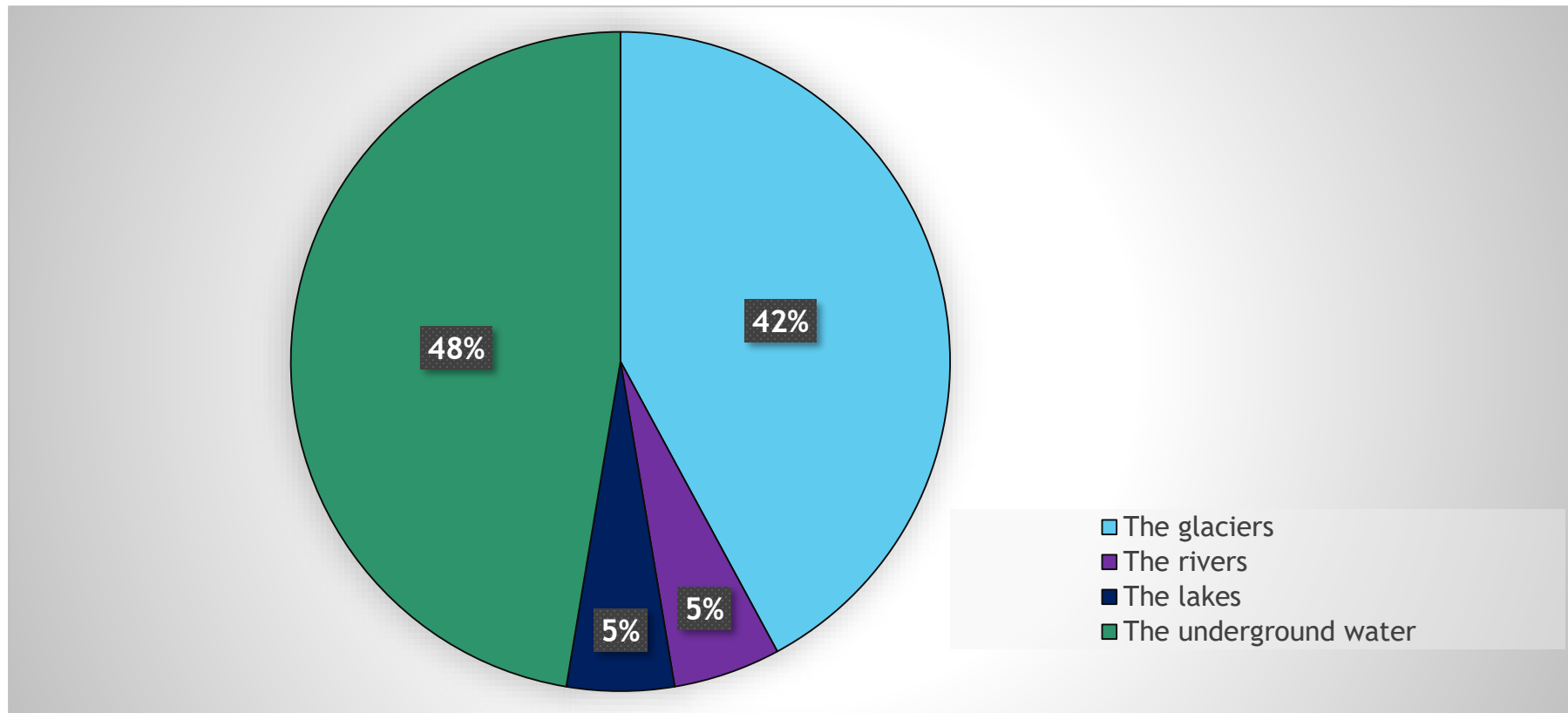

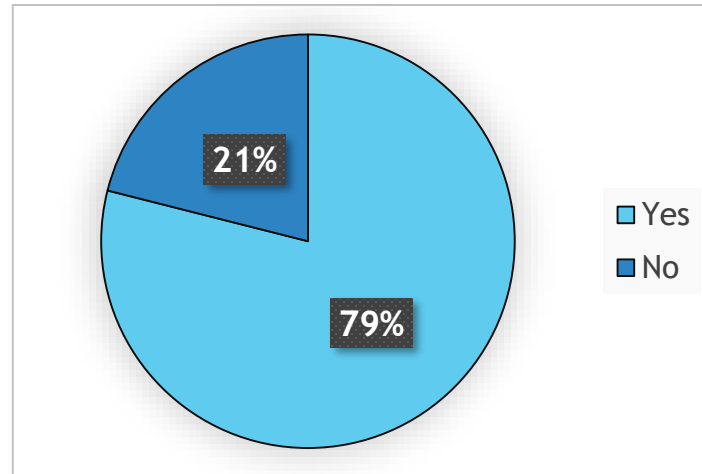

### Why Yes?

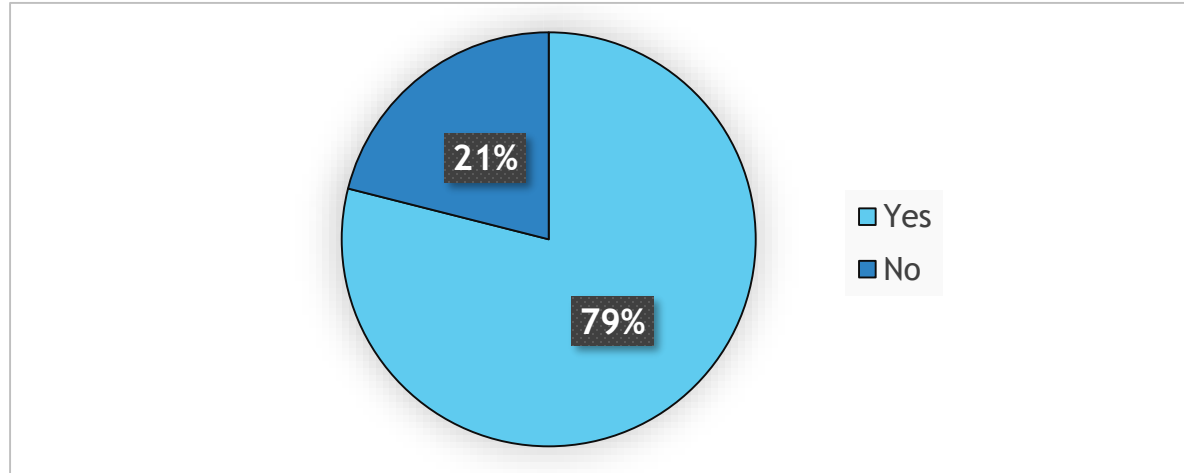
- Because, in my country, there are very big fresh water reserves

# 7. Can you drink water from the tap?



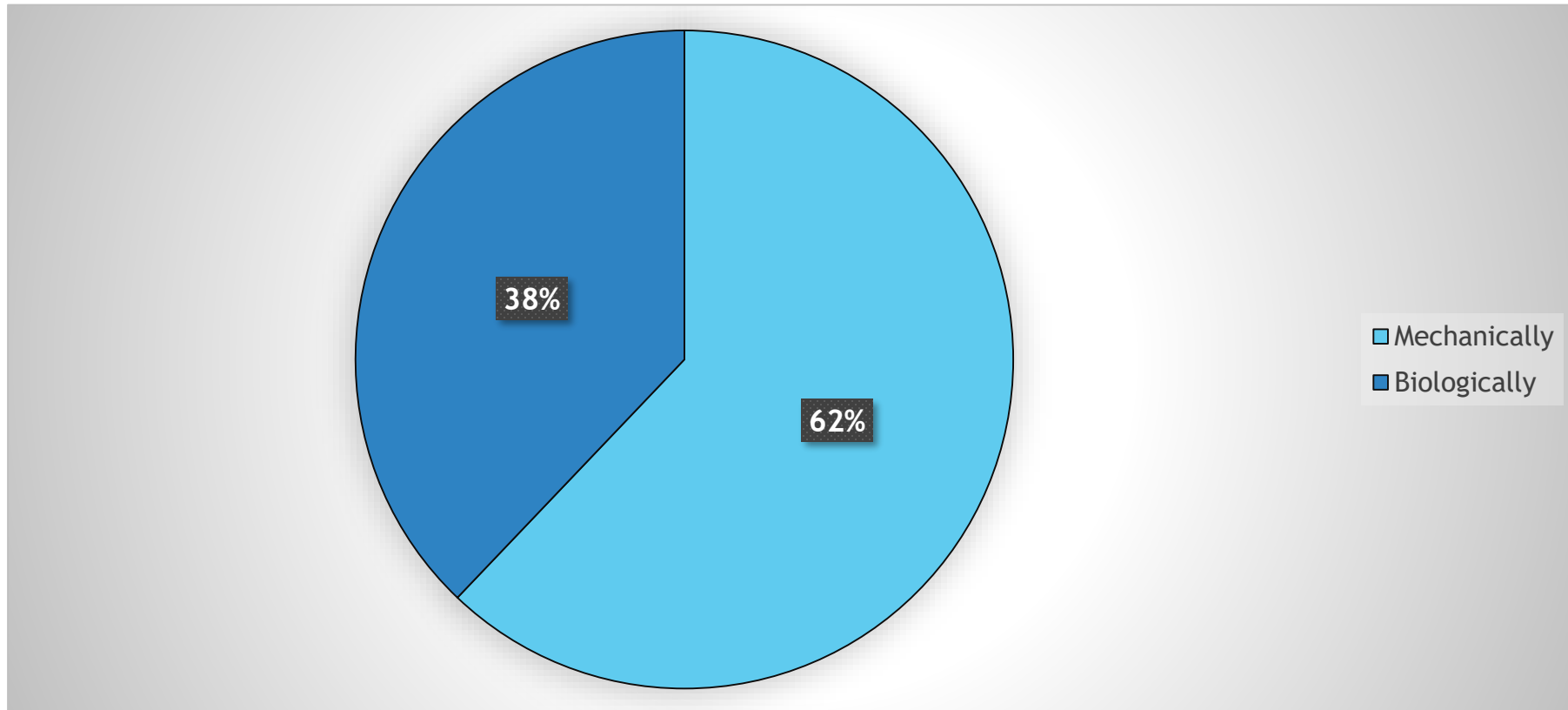
## Why Yes?

- If I can have a shower using this water, I can drink it as well

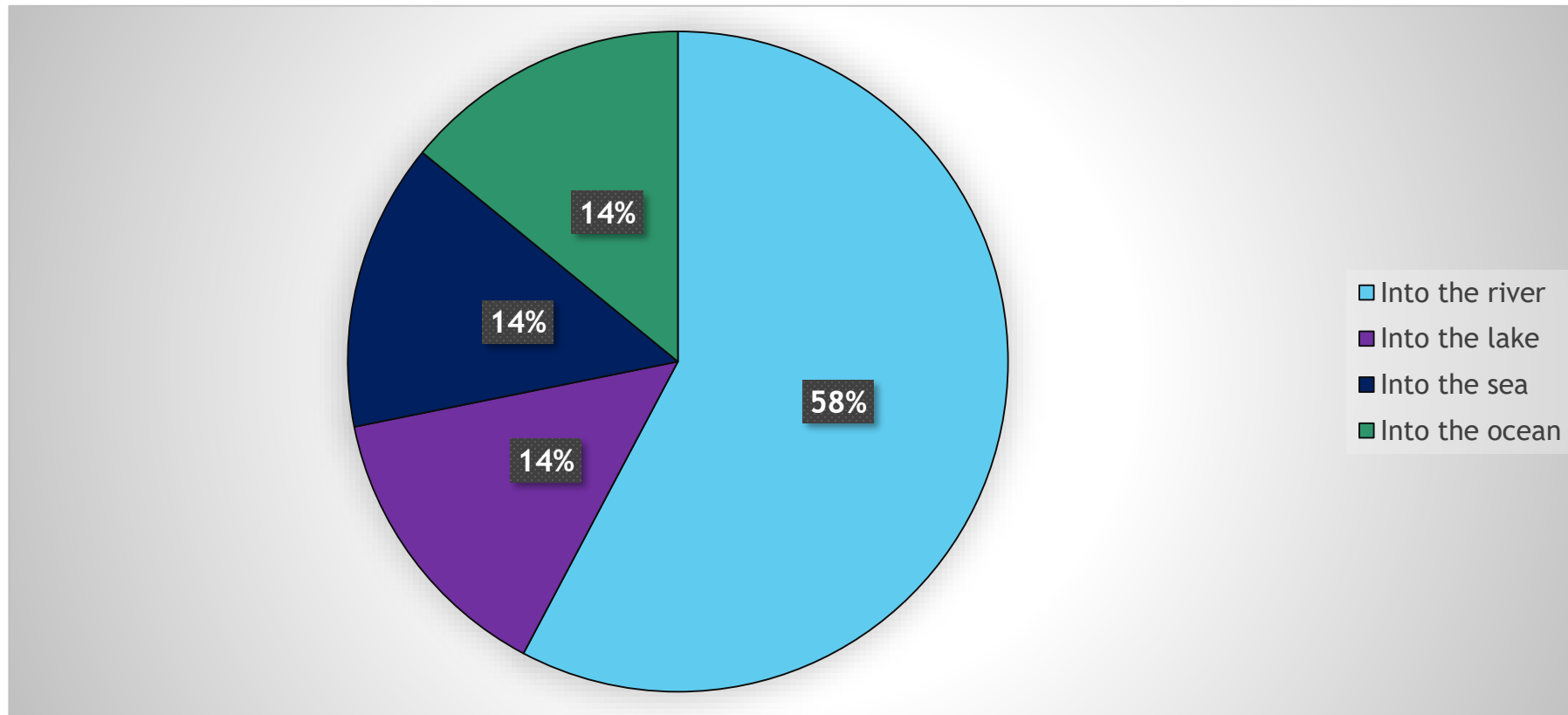
## Why No?
